

BANNED SINGLE-USE PLASTIC ITEMS

South Australia's *Single-use and Other Plastic Products (Waste Avoidance) Act 2020* is the first legislation of its kind in Australia. The following items have been or are planned to be banned.

BANNED 2021



Single-use plastic beverage stirrers



Single-use plastic cutlery



Single-use plastic drinking straws (exemptions apply)

BANNED 2022



Expanded polystyrene (EPS) cups, bowls, plates and clamshell containers



Oxo-degradable plastic products

BANNED 2023



Single-use plastic bowls and plates



Plastic-stemmed cotton buds



Plastic pizza savers

BAN PLANNED 2024



Thick supermarket or boutique plastic bags



Plastic barrier bags



Plastic confetti and balloon stick ties



Plastic bread tags



Single-use plastic food containers

Expanded polystyrene (EPS) consumer food and beverage containers



Single-use plastic beverage containers (including coffee cups)
